

Directions to Sir Thomas Boteler Church of England High School.

From the M56 or M6 South

- After leaving the M56 (J9)/M6 (J20) at LYMM, head for Warrington along the A50.
- After approximately 2 miles there is a crossroads with lights - travel straight ahead.
- After another 1.5 miles there is another set of lights with the swing bridge ahead (Manchester Ship Canal.)
- Go straight over the bridge, then immediately left into Station Road.
- Take the first right into Grammar School Road.
- The school entrance is on the left.

From M62 or M6 North

From M6 North/Junction 10 of M62 follow M6 Birmingham.

- Leave the M6 at junction 21 A57 Irlam/Warrington and follow signs to Warrington.
- After approximately 2 miles follow signs for A50 Macclesfield. (The Highwayman pub is on the left).
- Turn left at the lights.
- After 1.5 miles, take the right lane at the traffic lights. (Lidl supermarket is on the right). This is the one way system.
- Travel straight ahead and take the middle of the three lanes (A5061).
- Travel under the railway bridge and immediately turn right (before the swing bridge) into Station Road.
- Take the next right, Grammar School Road (one way street), and the school is located on the left. This is a one way road..

From Warrington Town Centre

- From Warrington town centre take the A5061 signposted Macclesfield, which becomes the A50.
- Pass the park on the left. After the hump backed bridge, the road splits into a dual carriageway.
- At the double traffic lights continue straight ahead.
- Take the middle of the three lanes. At the traffic lights ahead turn right and take the middle lane.
- Turn right into Station Road.
- Take the first right into Grammar School Road.
- The school entrance is on the left.
