### **Year 11 Transition Tours Warrington Vale Royal**

From the 25<sup>th</sup> May we will be running 1:1 Transition Tours for school leavers and their parents every other Wednesday until the 7<sup>th</sup> July. ### **Y8 Vaccines**

HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) vaccinations are being offered in school on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June. The HPV vaccination can help to protect young people against some types of HPV related cancers. The HPV vaccination programme in the UK consists of two doses of the vaccine for young people who start the course before their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday. The first dose of the vaccine is routinely offered in schools to boys and girls in year 8. A second dose is offered a minimum of 26 weeks after dose 1, which may not be in the same academic year. If you would like your child to receive this vaccine please follow the steps below to give consent. The consent process closes at 11am on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June.

5. If you are unable to complete the online consent form, please contact your local immunisation team on 01925 946808
