### **BTEC Sport Practical Exam – Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June**

The BTEC Sport practical exam has been confirmed for Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2022.

The practical assessment is an essential part of Unit 2 Practical Sport Performance which carries 30% of your child's final BTEC Sport grade. **Students must register on time with their form tutor as normal.** Students should attend all the sports they are being assessed in; they are highlighted on the timetable which has been included (attached).

**Students must check the sports they are to be examined in, the list of students for each activity is overleaf.** It is vital that your son/daughter comes prepared. Students should attend school in their full PE kit and register in the Ball Hall before each activity with a member of the PE team. They should bring both indoor and outdoor PE clothing as per school guidelines, this includes boots (only if being assessed in Rugby and/or Football) and trainers. Items with alternative brand markings to the school name and crest will not be permitted. Please bring plenty of water and healthy snacks.
