Thank you for your support in securing a place for your child on the cinema trip Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2024. We are now in a position to take payments for the trip and we very much hope the students are looking forward to it.

Please follow the link here, which will take you through to the school Ipay system, where you pay for the film that was selected on the consent form. Students who have remaining money from their Free School Meal voucher can use it to pay for their ticket and must advise us of this; please email your child's Head of Year. **LINK for IPAY: <https://www.ipayimpact.co.uk>, then select School Shop then School Trips.**

Further to the previous communication regarding the event, we can confirm that the students will be transported to Cineworld via coaches/busses that have arranged and funded by school. We will also ensure students have the opportunity to visit our canteen for an early lunch or provide them with a lunch to take if they are free school meals.

I will send final guidance for the day but please be reminded:

- Students do not need to wear school uniform; however, can I reinforce Mrs Scott-Herron's previous messages that cycling shorts or crop tops cannot be worn on non-uniform days.
- We will transport the students to the cinema from school in readiness for a 12pm start time (Time Square Unit 8, Warrington, WA1 2LH).
- Students can bring their own refreshments.
- Once in the cinema, students will not be able to leave the building until the end of the film.
- Students will be dismissed directly from the cinema, where parents/carers should note that the films will end before the 15.00 end of school day timing, therefore granting permission for their child to leave earlier than if they remained in school.
